Since Association incorporation:

- Over 15 years, Boroondara Netball Association has been working to develop young women and girls in sport

- Continue to work with council, state and federal government and other
 partnerships to enable the best outcomes for Boroondara residents for our sport,
 our health and our communities.

- Introduce new programs such as Rock Up Netball, Men & Boys Competition, Walking Netball and All Abilities Netball
- Introduce opportunities for mid-week and alternative competitions and programs
